I hope that that this finds you and yours safe and well, and adapting to these challenging times and day-to-day changes.

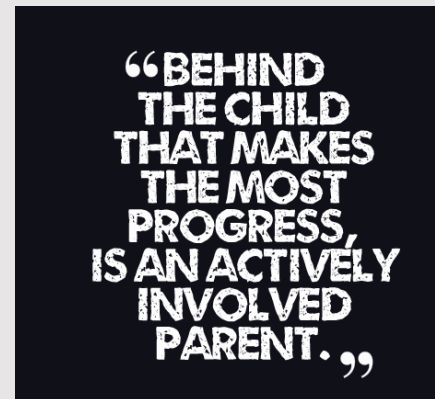
At PAC meetings, we get an update from the principal, a teacher representative and student council, as well as discuss and share key dates, activities and topics that impact our children.

REMOTE LEARNING NOW	K-12: Learning from home 100%	Full-time in-class learning only for children of essential workers and students who need support
GRADUAL RETURN JUNE 1	K - 5: In-class 50%, such as alternating days	Return to school is voluntary. Children may continue full-time remote learning until September
	6 - 12: In-class 20%, such as 1 day per week	
FULL RETURN SEPT 8	K-12: Learning in-class 100%	Provided it is safe to do so, and COVID-19 health and safety measures are in place
